Text: Proverbs 14:34

1. Wise nations understand the importance of their relationship with God

“Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.”
Proverbs 14:34

“Open the gates, that the righteous nation which keeps the truth may enter in.”
Isaiah 26:2

Wisdom Action: Pray for those who lead

Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity.” 1 Timothy 2:2 NLT

2. Wise nations understand the importance of wise leaders

“It is an abomination for kings to commit wickedness, for a throne is established by righteousness.” Proverbs 16:12

“Like a roaring lion and a charging bear is a wicked ruler over poor people.”
Proverbs 28:15

“If a ruler pays attention to lies, all his servants become wicked.” Proverbs 29:12

“A ruler who lacks understanding is a great oppressor...” Proverbs 28:16

Wisdom Action: Choose wise leaders

“Choose some well-respected men from each tribe who are known for their wisdom and understanding, and I will appoint them as your leaders.”
Deuteronomy 1:13 NLT

3. Wise nations understand the consequences of rejecting God

“Alas, sinful nation, A people laden with iniquity, A brood of evildoers, Children who are corrupters! They have forsaken the LORD, They have provoked to anger The Holy One of Israel, They have turned away backward.” Isaiah 1:4

“I will send him against an ungodly nation, And against the people of My wrath I will give him charge, To seize the spoil, to take the prey, And to tread them down like the mire of the streets.” Isaiah 10:6
